Acquisition finance and growth capital for Argentium International Limited ("AIL")

Magus Partners has advised AIL on its raising equity finance to acquire the intellectual property relating to the Argentium Silver alloy from Middlesex University and to support the growth of the business. Private investors have injected significant funding to develop global sales of the alloy and a worldwide distribution partnership has been entered into with Cookson Precious Metals, a division of the London-based FTSE 250 plc.

Argentium was originally developed in 1991 but is now being commercialised on a worldwide basis under CEO Richard Leyens. Clive Sanford has joined the Board as a non-Executive Director.

Argentium 970-Pure Silver is the whitest, most lustrous and most pure silver commercially available worldwide. It is also the most tarnish resistant silver available today – it is available in all forms, is fire-scale free and whilst perfectly malleable, can easily be made twice as hard as standard silver.
